

Critical. Cleanstone

Cleanstone is durable and low-maintenance, but following these simple care instructions will help maintain longevity and appearance over its lifetime.

GENERAL CLEANING TIPS

- Use a soft cloth or sponge with warm soapy water.
- For streak-free cleaning, use a mild glass cleaner.
- Always apply cleaners to a cloth first, rather than directly onto the surface.

CLEANING SPILLS & STAINS

- For everyday spills, wipe immediately with a damp cloth.
- For oily or greasy stains, use a mild detergent or diluted vinegar.
- For tough stains (ink, wine, coffee), use isopropyl alcohol or a non-abrasive household cleaner.
- Remove adhesives (glue, stickers) with citrus-based cleaners or mild solvents such as mineral turpentine.

DO NOT USE abrasive substances (scouring pads, steel wool, sand paper) or chlorine/ammonia-based products or harsh chemical solvents.

HEAT & IMPACT RESISTANCE

- Cleanstone is impact-resistant; however, repeated heavy impacts may cause minor dents on the panel surface.
- Avoid placing hot pans directly on the surface. Always use heat-resistant mats.

REFINISHING & RESTORATION

- For scratches or dull spots, Cleanstone can be sanded and polished back to its original finish.
- For deeper marks, use fine sandpaper (600+ grit) followed by a soft buffing pad.

RECYCLING CLEANSTONE

- Cleanstone is 100% recyclable.
- At the end of its lifecycle, return it to Critical. for recycling through Critical's Take Back programme to keep materials in circulation.
